Our Community Pool

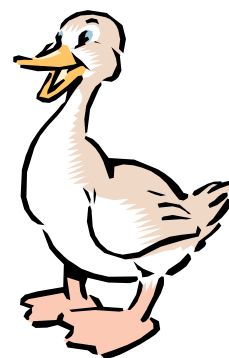
The pool area is for the enjoyment of the entire community, so it is important for everyone to follow the rules. If you notice anyone not abiding by the rules, not picking up after themselves or using pool parking for personal use, please feel free to speak up and let them know. We try to monitor the pool area; however we cannot be there at all times.

Garbage Information

We have dumpsters available for your garbage. All garbage must be placed *inside* the dumpsters. Please keep our neighborhood neat and tidy! If you have large items please call the City of Safety Harbor for pick up.

Large items, such as furniture, mattresses, etc. will be collected at no additional cost to the resident. Please place these items out on your regular scheduled garbage day. If you have more than two items, please call 724-1550. Items such as appliances will also be picked up free of charge by a separate crew at the end of the day, with the exception of appliances that contain freon. Those items will only be collected after the resident confirms a special pick-up fee of \$15.00 per unit for freon.

Curbside collection of recycling is one time per week. Items that can be recycled are newspapers, aluminum cans, and plastic (#1 & 2 only). All items must be curbside by 7 A.M. on Tuesday and can be co-mingled in your green recycling bin. Please place the newspapers at the bottom of the bin or tied in twine to prevent the wind from blowing them all over. Additional bins are available upon request to the City of Safety Harbor. Other items can be recycled at the drop off centers located in the city.



**Please
